FERAL EDUCATION GOALS

Using devised theatre techniques and creative play,
Feral Theatre strives to develop story-telling and collaboration skills in students of all ages. We prioritize helping students to find their own voices as artists through building individual confidence and creating supportive environments for all. Feral hopes to use site specific theatre and outdoor play to enhance the theatrical experience. All classes will end with an optional sharing presentation for the families.

BASIC CLASS STRUCTURE

Classes are flexible and can be altered to be one day workshops or to meet regularly over the course of several weeks. The class time would be evenly spent playing games to strengthen skills, doing exercises to learn new skills, and improvisation or devising work for the show creation. For longer classes, our goal is to include outdoor time for either structured work to be incorporated into the show or for some simple outdoor rec time. We plan to allow students to take on any role they wish during the show creation so as to not be limiting. This means that students who are non-vocal or simply do not wish to perform can participate in the creation and presentation of the show as well as students interested in acting. The "sharing" at the end of classes would be whatever the students wish to make of it: a typical theatrical performance, an immersive experience, or simply a presentation of projects and/or concepts covered during the
